Graduation Ceremony for Postgraduates



he Medical Postgraduate Graduation Ceremony for the year 2018 was held on the 5th November at the Ida Scudder Auditorium. The chief guest for the occasion was Professor Errol D'Souza, Director, Indian Institute of Management, Ahmedabad.

The graduation ceremony commenced with the time honoured tradition of the Jasmine Chain carried by the final year medical students, led by the Student Association President, Mr. Jerry Dominic John. The College Choir sang the invocation, following which Rev. Dr. Arul Dhas invoked God's blessings. The Auditorium echoed with 'Three Cheers for the Silver and Blue' as the graduates and faculty joined in the singing of the College Song. The Director, Dr. J.V. Peter welcomed and introduced the Chief Guest to the august gathering. Professor D'Souza was honoured with a bouquet, traditional shawl and a memento. This being the Centenary Year of Medical Education, the College Choir

beautifully rendered the Centenary Song, 'Home of Transformation'. In his charge to the postgraduates, the Vice Principal, Dr. Simon Pavamani congratulated them on reaching a new threshold in their journey and career. He exhorted them to practice both the science and art of medicine with a humanity and humility that ennobles their profession to a service and a vocation. The Principal, Dr. Anna B. Pulimood, administered the solemn pledge to the postgraduates.

In his address to the postgraduates, Professor Errol D' Souza advised the graduands to think of suffering beyond mere physical indicators and to consider the larger picture that revolves around the dignity and care of the patients.
