- Application should be approved and supported by the Head of the department or Institutional Head / Dean / Director.
- Registration will be done on a first come, first serve basis. Preference will be given to faculty actively involved in infection control in their hospital.
- Accommodation will be provided, only for first 20 participants on payment basis, on sharing basis.
