## <u>African Tulip Tree</u> **Common name:** African Tulip Tree, Scarlet-Bell or Fountain Tree **Botanical name:** *Spathodea campanulata* **Family:** Bignoniaceae; **Name in Tamil:** *Patadi*





**Field identification:** Tall, erect, deciduous tree up to 70 feet. Bark greyish brown, smooth. Large pinnate leave, opposite, oval leaflets with terminal leaflet. Leaflet furry turning smooth and glossy with age. Curved boat-shaped calyx, orange-crimson bell shaped blooms. Pod woody.

**Location on campus:** Scattered across campus. E.g. West of Scudder Hall, Scudder Crescent, Chapel Lawn
